## Attention Parents of 5th Grade Math Enthusiasts!

Math Olympiad will begin in January and be taught by Srta. Sidoine. Math Olympiad is an advanced level, state wide, middle school math competition for students in grades 5-8. Teams of 4 compete to gain as many points as possible across six components: a long session problem, and five short session problems in the content areas: Number Sense, Probability and Statistics, Measurement, Geometric Sense, and Algebraic Sense.

Mandatory practice sessions will be Monday and Wednesday mornings from 7:50-8:50 am starting in January. Attendance at the competition to be held on May 4, 2013 is also mandatory as well as completing homework packets (3-4 pages long) in addition to the regular classroom homework.
